

## VISA SECOND HOME ( INDEX E33 - 5 TAHUN )

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR SECOND HOME VISA	
NO	DOCUMENT
1	Valid national passport with a minimum validity of 36 months
2	Latest color passport photograph
3	Proof of minimum living expenses of USD 5,000
4	Statement of commitment, stating that the applicant will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Place funds in their own personal account at a state-owned bank (BNI, BRI, or Bank Mandiri) with a minimum amount of USD 130,000 or approximately IDR 2 billion</li> <li>• Or commit to purchasing residential property in the form of an apartment or condominium in Indonesia with a minimum value of USD 1,000,000 or equivalent</li> </ul>
5	Family Register
6	Applicant's personal Molina Immigration account

SECOND HOME VISA APPLICATION PROCESS	
NO	PROCESS FLOW
1	Creation of a Molina Immigration account, if the applicant does not already have one
2	Submission of Second Home E-Visa (Index E33) via Molina Immigration (estimated processing time: 3–5 working days)
3	After the E-Visa is issued, the applicant may enter Indonesia by presenting the E-Visa
4	Online ITAS will be sent via email or can be downloaded from the applicant's Molina Immigration account after arrival in Indonesia
5	<p>he applicant must report their arrival to the local Immigration Office according to domicile within a maximum of 90 days from the arrival date, by submitting the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Original Passport</li> <li>• ITAS Online</li> <li>• Bank statement / bank certificate from a state-owned bank confirming that the applicant has deposited a minimum of USD 130,000 or equivalent in their personal account;</li> <li>• Or attach a Property Ownership Certificate in Indonesia</li> <li>• Estimated reporting process: 5 working days</li> </ul>

1	Second Home Visa Fee (Visa Index E33): IDR 20,000,000 + 11% VAT / person
2	Reporting Fee at the Immigration Office: IDR 8,000,000 + 11% VAT / person
